A lampas motif of a bouquet of tulips, roses and asters, with ribbons and pearls on a sarin background, created in 1786 from a design by Desganges. This fabric was delivered in 1787 for the bedchamber of Louis XVI at the Palais de St Cloud, it was not sold during the 1789 revolution and was later used for the chamber of Napoleon at the Palais des Tuileries until 1808. Fabric to be cut by the repeat only
